




Commemorated on the Helles Memorial, Gallipoli. Inscription grave 34493, square 23 (Leonard Eugene Scott, died 15 December 1916).

George Prince Mountford Scudamore (1890-1915) - 2nd Lieutenant Royal Lancaster Regiment

Commemorated on the Menin Gate, Ypres, Belgium; inscription grave 35,441, square 120, (Robert Scudamore died 29 August 1908 age 54).

Donald Patrick Shaw (1888-1924) - Lieutenant-Colonel Dorsetshire Regiment Grave 36,460, square 82.





Harold Malcolm Simpson (1884-1916) - Private Canadian Infantry


Commemorated on the Menin Gate, Ypres; inscription grave 23,902, square 115, (John Simpson died 4 June 1918 age 69).

Commemorated on Chatham Naval Memorial; inscription grave 19158, square 32 (Zephaniah Simpson died 23 May 1913).




William Ronald Carde Simpson (1891-1915) - 2nd Lieutenant Border Regiment

Cyril Norman Sims (1895-1917) - Lance-Corporal Royal Fusiliers


